Károly Nendtvich (1811—1892)

Physician, first professor of chemistry (1847–1882), member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (1845), rector of the Technical University 1873/74.



Vince Wartha (1844–1914)

Chemist, professor of mineralogy (1867), professor of chemical technology 1870–1912, member (1873), vice-president (1908) of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, rector of the Technical University 1897/98, 1907–1910.





Lajos Ilosvay (1851–1936)

Pharmacist and chemist, professor of chemistry (1882–1934), member (1891), vice-president (1916) of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, state secretary of education (1914–1917), rector of the Technical University 1900–1903.



Imre Szarvasy (1872–1942)

Chemical engineer, professor of electrochemistry (1905–1942), member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (1910), rector of the Technical University 1925–1927.



Elek 'Sigmond (1873–1939)

Chemical engineer, professor of agricultural chemical technology (1910), member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (1915), director of the State Chemical Research Institute (1926–1934).




Ignác Pfeifer (1867–1941)

Chemical engineer, professor of chemical technology (1912–1922), later research director of the Tungsram Ltd.




Géza Zemplén (1883–1956)

Chemist, professor of organic chemistry (1913), member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (1923) and of the Academia Caesarea Leopoldina, Corvin-wreath (1931) and Kossuth Prize (1948) winner.

Chemical engineer, professor of agricultural chemical technology (1940).



István Náray-Szabó (1899–1972)

Chemical engineer, professor of physical chemistry (1938–1947), senior research scientist in the Central Chemical Research Institute (1956–1969).



Zoltán Csűrös (1901–1979)

Chemical engineer, professor of textile chemistry (1938–1946), professor of organic chemical technology (1946–1971), member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (1946), rector of the Technical University 1946–1949, 1957–1961, Kossuth Prize winner (1953), honorary doctor of the Technical University (1975).




Béla Lányi (1894–1964)


Rudolf Balló (1884–1969)

Chemical engineer, professor of organic chemistry (1950), head of the department (1956), Kossuth Prize winner (1949).




Károly Tettamanti (1912–1983)

Chemical engineer, professor (1969) and head (1977) of the Department of Unit Operations, member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (1982).


