This issue is a remarkable milestone in the renewal procedure of the Electrical Engineering Series of Periodica Polytechnica. The first task of the new Executive Editorial Board was to substitute traditional typesetting by desktop publishing methods. This issue is the first one of this kind. The preparation and printing time has been significantly reduced and stabilized: it now takes no longer than six months for an immediately accepted paper to appear.

Another issue directly touched upon by the reforms is the publishing policy. The Electrical Engineering Series of Periodica Polytechnica, which was a publication forum—first and foremost—for our university staff and for foreign colleagues working temporarily at the university, is now open to anybody who sends valuable material to the editor's office. The selection process, based on our reviewers' opinions, will judge scientific quality only.

We would like to encourage correspondence as well: reactions, complements, comments, criticisms or amendments to recently published papers are welcome and will be published without delay.

We hope very much that we will be able to contribute to a steady improvement of the journal's standard and request our readers to help our work with comments and suggestions.
